Agenda item heading Replacement of bollards around Recreational grounds car park	Date 21/04/2024
Why Over 16 years ago bollards were installed around the top car park in the Recreational grounds to stop cars driving on to the grounds, since then they have been subject to rot and damage from cars driving in to them. There are now a number of bollards missing which has provided access for cars to drive on to the Recreational grounds and has created a safety issue. The aim is to reinstall these missing bollards so this can not happen again. Due to the modern cars having a bigger overhang from the front and rear axel, the bollards will need be set back further from the curb, this is so as not to course any damage to cars that are parking nor will they themselves receive damage from vehicles. The 14 missing post will match the existing 6"x6"x2ft bollards that are already in situ.	
How (including Time and Money) This job will be submitted to an external contractor picked by DPC from the 3 quotes that I have obtained and submitted to all council members. (please see attached quotes) This works should be completed with in one day of the job starting. The money for this job should come from the newly obtained grant or from the reserved budget.	
When As soon as the council have picked one of the contractors, I will contact them that evening or the morning after depending on time for them to go ahead with the works.
